# Secretary's Summary of Online Board Meetings held since the previous Annual Membership Meeting

Date of report: 17 Oct 2024

Summary of Online 2024 Board Activities in roughly chronological order:

- 1. Daphe Lewis stepped down as Southeast Chapter Director, and Lawton Rogers will complete her Board term.
- 2. A FAQ page on bamboo.org was started.
- 3. The ABS ended 2023 on a positive note with good financial footing.
- 4. An ABS Mission Statement was crafted:

The American Bamboo Society is dedicated to expanding the understanding, appreciation, and utilization of bamboo. Through research, advocacy, education, and community outreach, the Society promotes the benefits of bamboo as a renewable and sustainable resource in horticulture, agriculture, art and industry.

- 5. At-Large Director Jenni Li resigned and was replaced by Autumn Ramsay to fill out Jenni's term. Jenni was also the ABS Advertising Chair.
- 6. The 2025 ABS Annual Meeting and Conference is planned for Greenville, South Carolina in mid-October. The tentative theme is "In the Groves". John and Michelle Tkach have been doing groundwork. A basic outline includes a 3-day program with tours of bamboo groves near Greenville.
- 7. ABS will become a sponsor of the World Bamboo Organization at the \$1000 per year level.
- 8. ABS membership reached 400 by 1 Sep 2024.
